
KAZIRANGA & MORE



DETAILED TRAVEL PLAN

Day 01 | Guwahati – Cherrapunjee (1300M) 185 kms/05 hrs

Reach Guwahati airport and drive to Cherrapunjee– once the heaviest rainfall area in the world. The drive will give us a spectacular view of deep gorges and the rolling hills luxurious with tropical vegetation that boast an innumerable variety of ferns, moss and orchids. On arrival check in at hotel.

Overnight Stay: in Deluxe Room at Hotel Polo Orchid / Similar Meals Included: B

Day 02 | Cherrapunjee - Full Day Caving

Meghalaya has more than 5000 caves out of which only 600 have been mapped till date. The Krem Mawmluh cave we take you to is a labyrinth of routes totaling about 7 kms. We reach Cherrapunjee, put on overalls and boots and with carbide lamps firmly put on head, we are all set for our adventure. We get into the cave through a small opening. Once inside, it is a different world altogether. We walk on sand and rocks, squeeze ourselves though narrow openings, sometimes on all fours. You will be able to see the impressive stalactite and stalagmite formations and water pools. Open your lunch hamper in one of the sandy chambers in the cave or finish caving and open the hamper outside on the rocks under the sun. Those not keen on caving, go for a sightseeing trip of Cherrapunjee.

Day 03 | Cherrapunjee – Kaziranga 302 kms/8 Hrs drive

After breakfast drive to Kaziranga. Check in to your room on arrival. Evening free at leisure. KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK - is a World Heritage Site, where more than 75% of the world's total population of the great Indian One Horned Rhinoceros can be found. It lies on the southern bank of the Brahmaputra River and is one of the oldest parks of Assam. Besides rhinos, the Asiatic Water Buffalo, Elephants, Tigers, Swamp deer, Barking deer and Hog deer can be seen. About 400 species of birds are found in Kaziranga National Park. Swamp Francolin, Great Hornbill, Pallas's Fish Eagle, Pied Falconets, Greater Adjutant Stork, Long Billed Vulture. There is no telling what one might find in Kaziranga but it is always a great experience. The specialty here is the Bluenaped pitta among a host of Raptors and Waterfowl. The adjoining buffer areas are worth a try too, as numerous rare sightings are reported regularly.

Overnight Stay: in AC Cottage at Diphlu River Lodge / similar Meals Included: B & D



Day 04 | Kaziranga

Early morning go for an elephant safari followed by jeep safari post breakfast. Afternoon go for jeep safari. Overnight Stay: in AC Cottage at Diphlu River Lodge / similar Meals Included: B, L & D

Timing (Kaziranga NP) Elephant Safari: Approximately 45 mins duration 05.30 to 06.30 06.30 to 07.30 JEEP SAFARI-Forenoon: Entry time between 0730 to 1000 Hours. No entry after 1000 Hrs Afternoon: Entry time between 1330 to 1500 Hours. No entry after 1500 Hrs . Visiting time till sunset.

Note:

- Elephant safari for foreign nationals are held only on Kaziranga Range, Kohora (Central Range)
- Allocation of elephant riding seats and timings are regulated by the forest department, Kaziranga National Park, Government of Assam. The tickets for the same are issued only on the previous evening of the ride after 7:30 PM.

Day 05 | Kaziranga – Guwahati (220 kms/ 05 hrs).

Post breakfast, transfer to Guwahati airport to board flight for onward destination Meals Included: B
